If you travel on the public transport network in Nottingham, getting around can be made easier with the Robin Hood card.

There are three different variations of the Robin Hood card:

- Season
- Pay-As-You-Go
- Flexible Days

Season: for frequent travellers. Available to use on most buses, the tram and the train in Greater Nottingham. Purchase 1, 3, 6 or 12 months travel.

Pay-As-You-Go: for occasional travellers. Multi-operator travel is capped at the best price for the day.

Flexible Days: for flexible travellers. Purchase 20 or 50 all-day travel passes, and use them when it's convenient for you.
