River Leen – Multi user path improvements (Birdcage Walk, King's Meadow, path adjacent to NG2 Business Park and Rennie Hogg path)

The River Leen flows from near Annesley until it joins the River Trent near the Meadows. This important green corridor and civic asset is being improved for biodiversity and recreation, including cycling and walking. Work will begin on 20 August 2018 and last for approximately eight weeks and include:


- Phase 1 (Birdcage Walk off Lenton Lane up to King's Meadow) 20 August to mid Sept – Path widening, resurfacing and fence repairs. During this time, the path will be closed in both directions to enable a shorter construction period and a signed diversion will be in place via Lenton Lane, Queens Drive, Tottle Road and Rennie Hogg Road and vice versa
- Phase 2 (King's Meadow, Rennie Hogg and NG2 Business Park paths) mid Sept to mid Oct – Installation of three new lighting columns on the path leading to Rennie Hogg Road, widening the path next to ng2 business park by moving lighting columns out of the path and resurfacing. The path at the southern end of ng2 will also be widened and resurfaced. During this time, the path will be closed in both directions and a signed diversion will be in place via Longwall Avenue and Crossgate Drive and vice versa
- Improved signage along the route throughout the programme

We apologise for any inconvenience these works may cause.
