River Leen – Multi user path improvements (Hill Side to Abbey Street)

The River Leen flows from near Annesley until it joins the River Trent near the Meadows, this important green corridor and civic asset is being improved for recreation and biodiversity; including cycling and walking.

Work will begin on 6 August 2018 for approximately nine weeks and include:

- 6 August to end August - Provision of a shared pedestrian cycle crossing on the Leen Gate Bridge and widened footways. Access to the QMC via Leen Gate will be maintained at all times. This will require stop and go boards at times to allow safe working and no parking within the vicinity of the works
- Late August for approx. two weeks - construction of a continuous footway giving pedestrian and cycle priority across the Hill Side/Derby Road junction. This is following resurfacing work completed in 2017. Access to Hill Side will be maintained at all times during the works
- September to early October – footpath widening, resurfacing and lighting column relocations on the path between Leen Gate and Abbey Street. During this time, the footpath will be closed in both directions and a signed diversion will be in place via Abbey Street and Leen Gate and vice versa
- Improved signage along the route throughout the programme.

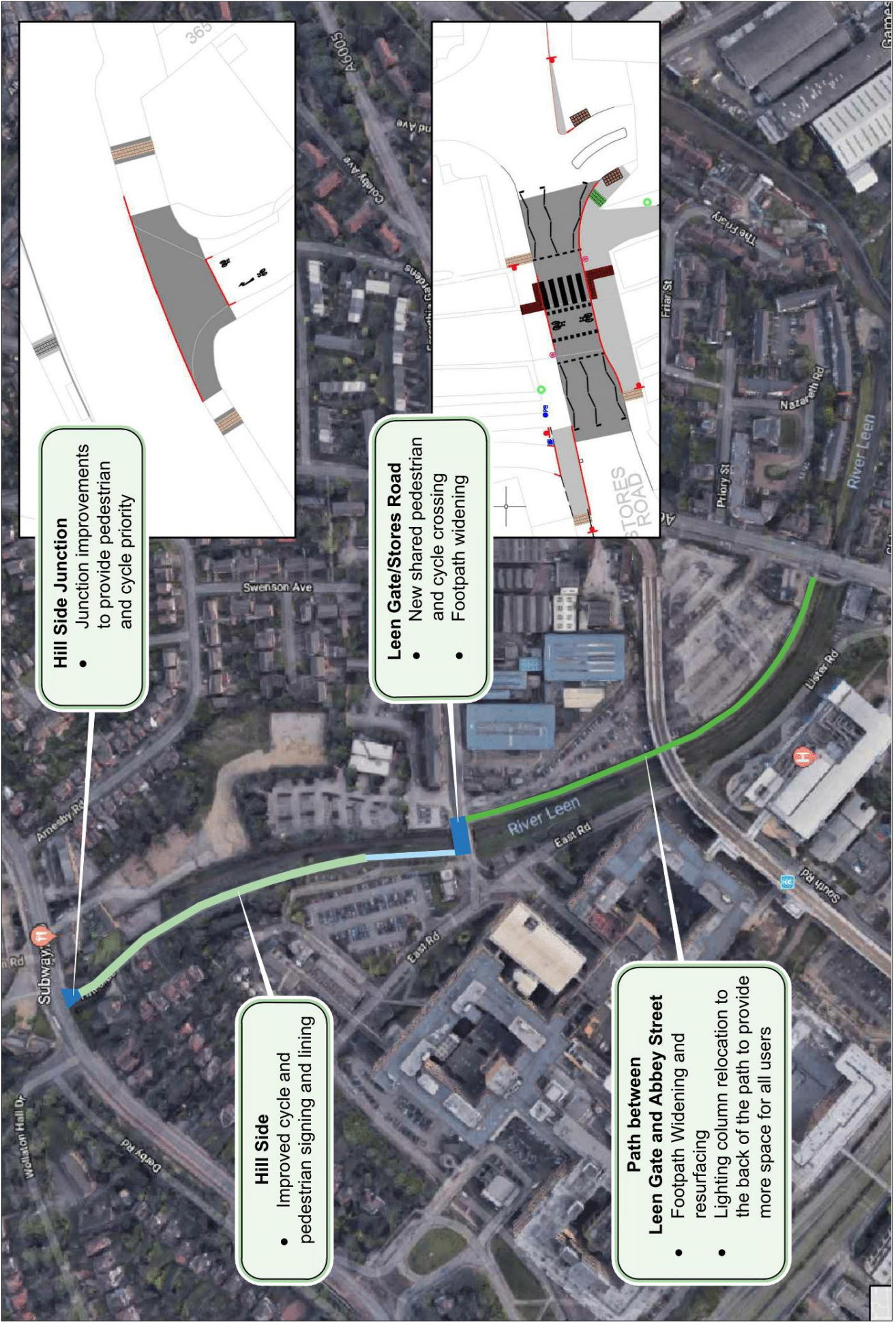
