



**NOTTINGHAM CITY COUNCIL (EMERGENCY ACTIVE TRAVEL ROUTE, PEEL STREET AREA, NOTTINGHAM) (TEMPORARY MOVING VEHICLE PROHIBITIONS/PROVISIONS) ORDER 2020 (TMT 4271M)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Nottingham City Council HAS MADE an Order, under Sections 14(1) and 16(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) being the traffic authority for the lengths of highway referred to in this Order is satisfied that the use of the said lengths of highway should be restricted by reason of public safety and the ability to social distance in connection with the Coronavirus, being on or near the length or lengths of highway referred to in this Notice, (in respect of a road or roads in the City of Nottingham).

The effects of the Temporary Order will be to apply the prohibitions/provisions listed below on the following roads:-

**Addison Street, Annesley Grove, Chatham Street, Dryden Street, Gill Street, Hampden Street, Newstead Grove, North Sherwood Street and Peel Street**

**MOVING PROHIBITIONS/PROVISIONS – TMT 4271M**

1. No Entry (except cycles) prohibition
2. No Entry prohibition
3. One Way Traffic provision

**IT IS INTENDED** that the prohibitions and restrictions respecting the above roads will apply as follows:-

From **Thursday, 10<sup>th</sup>** day of **September 2020** until **Monday, 31<sup>st</sup>** day of **January 2022** inclusive, **as required to ensure public safety in connection with the Coronavirus, by encouraging and enabling active travel modes**

**AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN** that during the period of restriction the alternative routes available will be indicated on site.

The Temporary Orders will come into force on **Thursday, 10<sup>th</sup>** day of **September 2020** and any prohibition and restriction in them shall apply on that day and any subsequent day when necessary to enable affective social distancing to take place. The Temporary Orders shall continue in force as required when appropriately signed (within a maximum period of 18 months).

The prohibitions are required to ensure public safety in connection with the Coronavirus, by encouraging and enabling active travel modes.
