## Hollington Road Improvements – Resurfacing Works

As works approach the final phases on Hollington Road, we will be undertaking resurfacing works to complete the Bathurst Roundabout phase of works. Resurfacing works are required to remove the depleted existing carriageway and improve the road surface for all road users.

Subject to weather, the resurfacing works will take place starting on 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2024 and lasting approx. 4 nights. These works will be undertaken during the hours of 8pm to 5am.

During this time we kindly ask that all vehicles are moved from these roads to enable the works to progress. Cones will be placed out in advance to prevent parking.

VEHCILES LEFT MAY BE REMOVED.

Access to private drives within these times will be limited during the works, and residents will be notified in advance by the site team.

Bus service 28 which use these routes will be affected and diverted throughout these times. We are working with local bus operators to agree these routes in advance.

Works will generate substantial amounts of noise throughout the use of heavy plant and machinery.
