



MAID MARIAN WAY IMPROVEMENTS (July 2025)



Road Closures and Diversions to Enable Road Surfacing – From July 21st to 14th August 2025

The Maid Marian Way improvement scheme is now nearing completion. As part of the final phase, we will soon begin resurfacing the surrounding roads that connect to the main junction at Maid Marian Way, Derby Road, Upper Parliament Street, and Tollhouse Hill.

The works are scheduled to take place overnight, between 22:00 and 06:00, from Monday to Thursday, over a period of approximately four working weeks. To minimise disruption to Nottingham's vibrant nighttime economy, no works will be carried out on Friday, Saturday, or Sunday nights.

Pedestrian routes will remain open as usual during this period; however, minor diversions may be in place to ensure the safety of the public, motorists, and our workforce.
