## Porchester Road Active Travel Scheme - Start of Works – Phase 2

Following the completion of the first phase of the Porchester Road Active Travel Scheme, from Burgass Road to Cherrywood Gardens, work will begin on the second phase, from Cherrywood Gardens to Emmanuel Avenue, on **Monday 24<sup>th</sup> March 2025** and is programmed to take 12 months.

To allow us to carry out this second phase of cycleway works it will, at times, mean:

- Temporary footpath closures diversions will always be in place and clearly signed.
- Parking restrictions will be introduced, when necessary, along Porchester Road but alternative parking at other locations will remain available.
- Temporary traffic signals will be in place and traffic lanes temporarily reduced. Layout changes will be clearly signed.
- Side roads at junctions with Porchester Road will need to close for short periods. Only one side road junction will be closed at a time. When these unavoidable closures are in place, a clearly marked alternative route will be available.
- Temporary bus stops in place.

Phase 2 work comprises the construction of a segregated two-way cycle path to the west of the road between Cherrywood Gardens and Kenrick Road and one-way cycle paths for northbound and southbound users from Kenrick Road to Emmanuel Avenue. Improvements will also be made to road crossings and junctions to improve walking routes and accessibility of footways for all users.

The scheme will provide a safer walking and cycling route for those travelling to and from residential areas, businesses, the Hogarth Academy and city centre destinations. Funding for Porchester Road walking and cycling improvements has come from Central Government via the newly formed East Midlands Combined Counties Authority. The design and costs of the Porchester Road scheme was assessed and approved by Active Travel England as part of the process.

In the interim, ahead of the phase 2 cycleway works starting, footway resurfacing works will be taking place along Porchester Road. This work will be undertaken by our subcontractor, Colas, who will notify affected residents separately, 48 hours before undertaking the work.
