Improving your roads



Nottingham City Council is improving your road

We have started work on Arleston Drive using temporary traffic signals to safely conduct the preparatory works ahead of when we need to close the road. This will be in phases starting on 4th August until 1st September. Hours of work will be 8am to 5pm, Monday to Friday only.

How will this affect you?

All Phases

- All restrictions are in operation during working hours only.
- Local diversions in place (see plan overleaf).
- Pedestrian access is always maintained.
- If you live on Goodwood Road, Deepdale Road or a cul-de-sac off Arleston Drive there will be restrictions on which direction you can turn out of your road depending on which phase we are working on.
- Bins will be collected on your usual day before 7am.

Phase 1 Trowell Road to Renfrew Drive, 11th August to 19th August

- Please do not park your car on the road during the hours of work.
- Vehicle access to driveways will be maintained where possible, although there may be times when this is limited.

Phase 2 Renfrew Drive to Wollaton Vale, 4th to 8th August and 20th August to 1st September

- Please do not park your car on the road during the hours of work.
- Vehicle access to driveways will be maintained where possible, although there may be times when this is limited.
