Nottingham City Council is planning to improve Old Lenton Street at its junction with George Street and George Street raised plateau

Nottingham City Council is improving your area and will soon be starting work to improve the highway. The improvements include:

- Old Lenton Street at its junction with George Street - changes to the southeast kerb line (Nottingham Arts Theatre side)
- George Street – resurfacing of the raised plateau

Work will begin on 15th September and will take around 4 nights to complete. Hours of work will be 11.30pm to 6.00am. Outside of these times parking and access is unaffected.

How will this affect you?

- Old Lenton Street will be closed at its junction to George Street.
- Parking bays outside 14-16 George Street will not be in use.
- Bollards on Broad Street will be removed, and a diversion route will be in place along Broad Street and George Street.
- The George Street raised plateau will be resurfaced in two halves to maintain the traffic flow on George Street.
- A traffic safety control officer will always be on site to monitor traffic.
