Bus Priority Scheme: Start of Construction Works and Temporary Parking Restrictions

Further to our previous letter outlining the proposed improvements to Meadows Way as part of the Greater Nottingham Bus Service Improvement Plan, we are writing to inform you that construction of the scheme is now due to begin.

As highlighted previously, the scheme will deliver a number of benefits for local bus users, residents, pedestrians and cyclists by improving journey time reliability, updating crossing facilities, and providing enhanced parking arrangements away from the main road. These works include:

- New bus lanes
- Relocation of bus stops
- Removal of the existing zebra crossing and installation of a new push-button pedestrian crossing
- Extension of off-street parking areas
- Removal of on-street parking on Meadows Way and provision of a new right-turn pocket into Mabel Street
- Improvements to footways
- Improvements to cycle facilities

To allow us to safely construct these improvements, temporary parking restrictions will be required. These restrictions are essential to ensure safe working areas for our construction teams and to maintain the efficient flow of traffic during the works.

Works will take place in phases to minimise disruption and ensure that alternative parking options remain available. Advance warning signs will be installed on site ahead of each phase.

As illustrated on the plan enclosed with this letter, during the first phase, no parking will be permitted from 23 March 2026, within the residents' car park on Uppingham Gardens.

During the second phase, no parking will be permitted from 16 April 2026, within the residents' car park on Lammas Gardens.




