Nottingham City Council is planning to improve your road

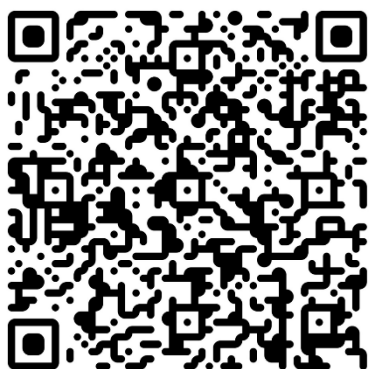
We are resurfacing Sherborne Road between Seaton Crescent and Minver Crescent and preparing Sherborne Road between Broxtowe Lane and Seaton Crescent for future resurfacing; by undertaking preparatory work here only (this section has been omitted from this resurfacing programme as Severn Trent Water (STW) have necessary works here – communications on this will be sent out by STW shortly). Our work will begin on 20th October until 31st October between 8am to 5pm on weekdays only.

How will this affect you?

Sherborne Road/Tunstall Crescent junction (near numbers 47 and 38) will be closed at all times to allow for the location of the compound.

Restrictions that will take place during working hours only are:

- Sherborne Road will be closed except for access; local diversions will be in place.
- No parking to take place on Sherborne Road.
- Vehicle access to driveways will be maintained where possible, although there may be times when this is limited.
- Buses will use diversion routes. Please see the Nottingham City Transport website for further details of this www.nctx.co.uk/service-updates
- To work safely at the junctions of Broxtowe Lane and Minver Crescent we will occasionally need to use temporary stop/go boards to control traffic.
- Pedestrian footways will remain in use.
- Bins will be collected on your usual day before 7am.
