Nottingham City Council is planning to improve your road

We are planning to resurface Wilford Crescent East.

Work will begin on 22nd September and will take just over three weeks to complete. Working hours will be 8am to 5pm, Monday to Friday and Saturday 4th and 11th October. Please see the information below for further details.

How will this affect you?

All Phases

- Please put your bin out early, these will be emptied before 7am on your usual day.
- The road will be closed to traffic as per the phases below. There will be no parking during working hours. Please use the alternative Lamcote Grove Resident Parking Area to park during this time. Roads include Wilford Crescent East (Bathley Street to Mundella Road), Mundella Road, Bathley Street, Bunbury Street, Lamcote Grove and Muskham Street. Nottingham City Council Parking Regulation and Compliance Team are aware of this temporary arrangement.
- Local diversions will be in place.
- Pedestrian access will always be maintained.

Phase 1 - Wilford Crescent East (Bathley Street to Green Street)

- 22nd September to 2nd October and 14th and 15th October

Phase 2 - Wilford Crescent East (Wilford Grove to Bathley Street)

- 3rd October to 13th October
