## Nottingham City Council is planning to improve your road

We are resurfacing parts of Woodkirk Road. This will be from 4<sup>th</sup> November to 13<sup>th</sup> November. Monday to Fridays, between the hours of 9.30am to 3.30pm. All restrictions below are during working hours only.

## How will this affect you?

- Woodkirk Road will be closed except for access; local diversions will be in place.
- No parking to take place on Woodkirk Road.
- Vehicle access to driveways will be maintained where possible, although there may be times when this is limited.
- To work safely at each end of Woodkirk Drive with Colleymoor Leys Lane and Swansdowne Drive we will occasionally need to use temporary two-way lights to control traffic.
- If you live on Belwood Close, there will be restrictions on which direction you can turn out of this road depending on where we are working on Woodkirk Road. Disruption to access may also occur whilst we resurface the junction of Woodkirk Road/Belwood Close.
- Pedestrian footways will remain in use.
- Bins will be collected on your usual day before 7am.
