Improving your roads



Nottingham City Council is planning to improve your road

We are resurfacing Colville Street. Work will begin on 10th November to 27th November. Hours of work will be 8am to 5pm on weekdays only. **All restrictions below are during working hours only.**

How will this affect you?

- Colville Street will be closed except for access; local diversions will be in place.
- No parking to take place on Colville Street. For those properties with resident parking permits please use alternative roads within the Forest Road East Residents Parking Area such as Addison Street, Newstead Grove and Annesley Grove. Forest Road East, which is unrestricted for parking, can also be used. Nottingham City Council's Parking Regulation and Compliance Team are aware of this temporary arrangement.
- Vehicle access to driveways and to Forest Grove parking bays will be maintained where possible, although there may be times when this is limited.
- To work safely at each end of Colville Street, at Forest Road East and Addison Street, we will occasionally need to use temporary two-way lights to control traffic whilst we work close to these junctions.
- Pedestrian footways will remain in use.
- Bins will be collected on your usual day before 8am.
- Pedestrian footways will remain in use.
