Nottingham City Council is continuing to improve your area

Thank you for your patience whilst we recently resurfaced Nuthall Road between Llanberis Grove and Western Boulevard.

As part of our whole-street approach to improving local communities, we are returning to Nuthall Road. Our aim is to make a visible improvement to the area by carrying out additional maintenance works along the footpaths. These works will include:

Improvements to the footways where required including resurfacing, renewal
of damaged block paving, cleaning of existing block paving, new signs and
posts, new bins, removal of tree stumps and new tree pit areas around
existing trees.

During December we plan to work on the footways and damaged block paving between Denehurst Avenue and Melbourne Road both sides. Hours of work will be 8.00am to 5.00pm weekdays only.

How will this affect you?

- There will be no further work affecting the road, so parking and loading is unaffected.
- Pedestrian footways and crossings will remain in use.
- There will be areas of footway with open excavations and barriers. This is to keep these working areas enclosed and safe and will not affect access to your premises.
