Improving your roads



Nottingham City Council is planning to improve your road

We are applying high friction surfacing at the Woodhouse Way/Strelley Road/Bilborough Road and Princess Boulevard/Woodhouse Way junction and making drainage improvements near to Princess Boulevard on Woodhouse Way. This will be from 24th November 2025 though to 28th November 2025. Working hours will be 8pm to 6am.

How will this affect you?

All Phases

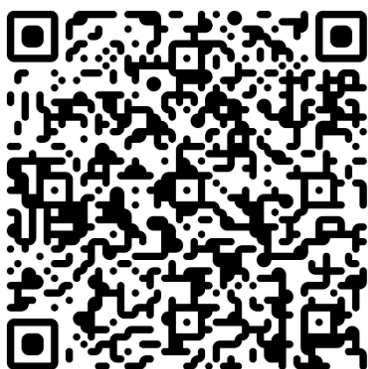
- Access to Princess Boulevard will be via Chatterley Parkway.
- Buses will not be affected as services operate outside of these times.

Phase 1 - Northbound side: 24th, 25th & 27th November 2025

- The road will be closed; signed diversion routes will be in place.
- Access in and out of Strelley Village will be straight ahead via Strelley Road only.

Phase 2 - Southbound side: 26th & 28th November 2025

- The road will be closed, signed diversion routes will be in place.
- Access into Strelley Village will be via left turn only from Bilborough Road /Woodhouse Way arm of the junction.
- Access out of Strelley Village will be left turn only onto Woodhouse Way arm of the junction.
