Nottingham City Council is improving Crossing Facilities on Alfreton Road

Further to the previous consultation letter dated 10th December 2025, Nottingham City Council will soon be starting work to introduce improved pedestrian crossing facilities on Alfreton Road as per the plan overleaf.

Work will start on Monday 19th January 2026 and continue until the end of March 2026.

How will this affect you in general?

- There will be lane closures in place on Alfreton Road between the hours of 9.30am to 3.30pm.
- The road will be closed to traffic towards the end of March 2026; this will be during the nighttime so we can resurface the road whilst the network is least busy. We will let you know nearer the time the dates for this and how this may affect you.
- Whilst works progress past Bus Stop RA32 a temporary stop will be provided in an appropriate location nearby to ensure minimal disruption.
- Residents will be notified daily / weekly as works progress, if there is going to be any disruption to your access.
