Nottingham City Council is planning to improve your road

Nottingham City Council is improving Flaxton Way from Ridgeway to past Chichester Close. These works include junctions with Thornbury Way and Chichester Close.

Work will start on Monday 2nd March for 5 days, between the hours of 8am to 5pm.

How will this affect you in general?

- Bin collections will still be collected on your usual day, please ensure these are placed outside your property before 8am.
- The road will be closed and there will be no parking within the area of work. Local diversions routes will be in place.
- Vehicle access to Chichester Close and Thornbury Way will be restricted during working hours, more so on 4th and 5th March whilst resurfacing is taking place.
- Stacey Avenue will be closed for the duration of the works at its junction with Ridgeway. This is to facilitate a compound area for the work. A local diversion will be in place.
- At times during the works temporary traffic lights will be in use on Ridgeway.
- Pedestrian access will be always maintained.
