Nottingham City Council is continuing to improve your area

Thank you for your patience whilst we recently resurfaced Nuthall Road between Llanberis Grove and Western Boulevard.

As part of our whole-street approach to improving local communities, we are continuing work on Nuthall Road. Our aim is to make a visible improvement to the area by carrying out additional maintenance works along the pavements. This includes:

- Improvements to the footways where required including resurfacing, renewal of damaged block paving, cleaning of existing block paving, new signs and posts, new bins, removal of tree stumps and new tree pit areas around existing trees.

From late February to May 2026, we plan to work on the pavement and damaged block paving from Bar Lane towards Western Boulevard on the Newcastle Arms side of the road. Hours of work will be 8.00am to 5.00pm weekdays only.

How will this affect you?

- A lane closure will be in place near to where works are to take place.
- Bus stops may need to be closed while we work near to them.
- We will need to work near parking/loading/shop front/housing accesses but will keep disruption to a minimum. We will always let you know if our work does affect you before we commence.
- There will be areas along the pavement with open excavations and barriers. This is to keep these working areas enclosed and safe.
- Pavements and pedestrian crossings points will remain in use.
