Nottingham City Council is planning to improve your road

Nottingham City Council is improving Strelley Road slip Road.

Work will start on Monday 2nd March and continue until 10th March. This will be Monday to Friday only, hours of work will be 8am to 5pm.

How will this affect you in general:

- No parking to take place on the road as per the phases below. Please note these phases do swap around from one day to the next due to the construction, so we suggest planning your parking and access ahead.
- Vehicle access to driveways will be maintained where possible, although there may be times when this is limited.
- Pavements will remain in use.
- Bins will be collected on your usual day before 8am.

How will each phase affect you:

Phase 1 – House Number 73 to 103 2nd, 4th, 5th and 10th (half day) March

- This section of the road will be closed.
- Access to Yatesbury Crescent will be via St Martin's Road end of Strelley Road.

Phase 2 – House Number 105 to 137 3rd, 6th, 9th and 10th (half day) March

- This section of the road will be closed.
- Access to Yatesbury Crescent will be via Denewood Crescent end of Strelley Road.
