Nottingham City Council is improving your road

We are resurfacing Aspley Lane at its junction with Melbourne Road / Robin's Wood Road. Work will begin on 18th May and continue until 29th May 2026. Please see information below & overleaf for further details.

How will this affect you?

Week 1: 18th - 22nd May 9.30am - 3.30pm

- Aspley Lane will be closed to traffic in one direction. It will remain open for traffic heading towards Western Boulevard. A signed diversion will be in place for traffic heading out of the city towards Broxtowe Lane.

Week 2: 26th - 29th May (Half term) 8am - 5pm

- Aspley Lane will be closed to traffic in one direction. It will remain open for traffic heading towards Western Boulevard. A signed diversion will be in place for traffic heading out of the city towards Broxtowe Lane.

During the works

- Melbourne Road and Robin's Wood Road will be closed at the junction with Aspley Lane. Local diversion routes will be in place.
- For no-through roads (Eskdale Drive, Lambert Gardens and St Margarets Avenue), located off Aspley Lane, access will be provided via the signed diversion route with appropriate left turn or right turn maneuvers to egress.
- Bus stops within the closure area will not be in use. Please use alternative stops nearby
- No parking to take place on the road within the work area.
- Vehicle access to driveways will be maintained where possible, although there may be times when this is limited.
- Pedestrian footways will remain open during the works.
- Bins will be collected on your usual day before 7am.
