## Nottingham City Council is improving your road at Denman Street West

Nottingham City Council is improving Denman Street West from St Peter's Street to the school entrance. Work will start on Monday 20<sup>th</sup> April and continue until Monday 27<sup>th</sup> April, weekdays only, and will be completed in 2 phases as detailed below:

- Phase 1 - 20<sup>th</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> April (8am to 5pm)
  - Denman Street West will be closed, and local diversions will be in place. Access to the school car park will be maintained for vehicles via Croydon Road.
- Phase 2 - 24<sup>th</sup> April (5pm to 10pm)
  - Denman Street West will be closed at its junction with the school whilst we resurface near to the school entrance.
- There will also be 2 way temporary traffic lights at the junction of Denman Street West and St Peters Street on 20<sup>th</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> April.

### How will this affect you in general?

- Bin collections will still be collected on your usual day, please ensure these are placed outside your property before 8am.
- The road will be closed and there will be no parking within the area of work, during working hours. Local diversions routes will be in place.
- Pedestrian access will be always maintained.
