Nottingham City Council is improving your road

Nottingham City Council is resurfacing Orston Drive from Middleton Boulevard (Calver Close end) to near number 63 Orston Drive.

Work will start on Monday 13th April and continue until Monday 27th April, weekdays only and in 2 phases as below:

Phase 1 – 13th April to 17th April (8am to 5pm)

Preparation work for the resurfacing will be undertaken. The road will be closed at its junction with Middleton Boulevard.

Phase 2 – 20th April to 27th April (9.30am to 3.30pm)

Resurfacing will take place and the road will be closed at its junction with Middleton Boulevard.

How will this affect you during each phase ?

- The road will be closed and there will be no parking on the road within the area of work, during working hours. Local diversions routes will be in place.
- Vehicle access to driveways will be maintained, although there will be times when this is severely limited due to the width of the road.
- A site compound will be located on Harby Drive. Access onto Harby Drive will be from Middleton Boulevard and for resident access only. There will be no through route onto Orston Drive.
- Pavements will remain in use.
- Bin collections will still take place on your usual collection day; please ensure bins are placed outside your property before 8am.

The following restrictions are for phase 2 only:

- Bus stop WO26 (near the subway) and the bus layby will be closed for the full duration of phase 2, with a temporary bus stop to be located nearby. Access to driveways within the bus stop layby on Middleton Boulevard will be maintained.
- Bus stop WO35 (near Newland Close) will be closed from 9.30am – 3.30pm and a temporary stop located nearby.
