Hounds Gate – footway resurfacing

Nottingham City Council is improving the footways on Hounds Gate.

Work will commence on 1st June 2026 and will continue until 10th July 2026, working hours will be 08:00 – 16:00, Monday to Friday and weekends where necessary.

How will this affect you in general?

- For the duration of the footway works, due to the width of Hounds Gate, a one-way system will be in operation on Hounds Gate i.e. from Spaniel Row to Wheeler Gate, with a diversion route in place for general traffic along Spaniel Row, Friar Lane and Wheeler Gate.
- Access to existing car parks on Hounds Gate will be maintained, together with access for deliveries. Footway works directly outside some business entrances may require completing outside normal working hours to maintain access. There will be a Traffic Management operative on site to assist with marshalling the traffic.
- It will be necessary to close sections of the footways on either side of the road, during which time, pedestrians will be diverted onto the opposite footway. Pedestrian and vehicular access will be maintained at all times.
- Bin collections will still be collected on your usual day, please ensure these are placed outside your property before 8am.
