

Highways Planned Maintenance

Improving your roads



Nottingham City Council is planning to improve your road

We are resurfacing Abbey Bridge and Abbey Street, together with the Gregory Street / Leen Gate junction.

Work will begin on Monday 17th August and will be completed by 6am on Thursday 3rd September. Work hours will be 7pm to 6am weeknights only. Please see information below and attached plan for details of the general traffic diversion route.

How will this affect you?

- All restrictions are in operation during working hours only.
- There will be no parking, loading, or unloading on Abbey Bridge, Abbey Street and Gregory Street including the junction with Leen Gate.
- The road will be closed to general traffic.
- Local access will be maintained for:
 - Warwick Street, Cloister Street, Priory Street, Gregory Street, Coleby Avenue, Hoyland Avenue

However, this will be subject to restricted turning movements (left turn only or right turn only). There will be times when access is severely restricted, the contractor and traffic management operatives will be on site to marshal vehicles through the works to maintain safety.

- Buses that use Abbey Street and Abbey Bridge will follow a diversion route.
- Access to the Queen's Medical Centre will be via the main vehicle entrance off Derby Road (A52).
- Nottingham Express Transit (NET) trams using Gregory Street will continue to run as normal.
- Any noisy work will endeavor to be completed by 10:30pm each night.
- A pedestrian route will always be maintained.
- The cycle route will remain open, but the crossing points will not. Take additional care when crossing the road.

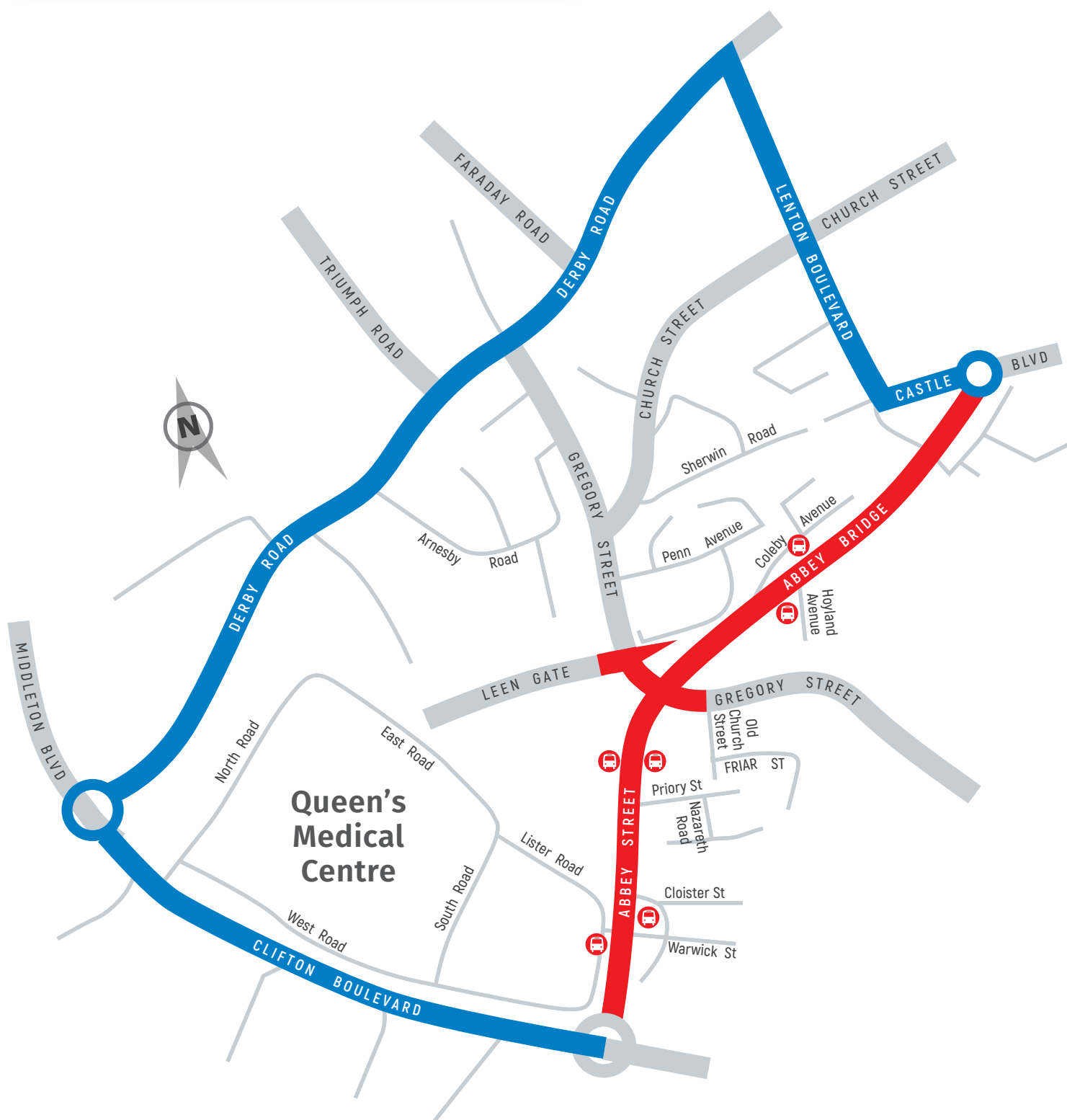
