

Highways Planned Maintenance

Improving your roads



Nottingham City Council is planning to improve your road

We are resurfacing the full length of Beeston Road and a short length of University Boulevard, between Jesse Boot Avenue and George Green Way.

Work will begin on 7th September, continuing until 17th September. The hours of work will be 7pm to 6am (Monday to Friday). Please see information below and attached plans for further details on the road closure and diversion routes.

How will this affect you?

Carriageway resurfacing operations will require closure of Beeston Road and University Boulevard (between Queens Road East and Clifton Boulevard), during this time a signed diversion route will be in operation.

- All restrictions are in operation during working hours only.
- The road will be closed to general traffic.
- Local access will be maintained for:
 - Greenfield Street, East Drive, Science Road, Highfield Road, Ednaston Road, Lace Street, City Road, George Green Way, Jesse Boot Avenue, Brailsford Road, Montpelier Road, Marlborough Street, Dunkirk Road, Claude Street, Bunting Street, Tonnelier Road and Barrique Road.

However, this will be subject to restricted turning movements (left turn only or right turn only). There will be times when access is severely restricted, the contractor and traffic management operatives will be on site to marshal vehicles through the works to maintain safety.

- A pedestrian route will always be maintained; however signalised crossings will be out of use during the works.
- Access to businesses will be maintained but will be restricted at some points during the works.
- There will be no parking, loading or unloading on Beeston Road and University Boulevard (within the work area).
- Any noisy work will endeavour to be completed by 10:30pm each night.
- Buses that use Beeston Road will follow a diversion route during the hours of work.
- Tram services on University Boulevard will be unaffected by the resurfacing works.

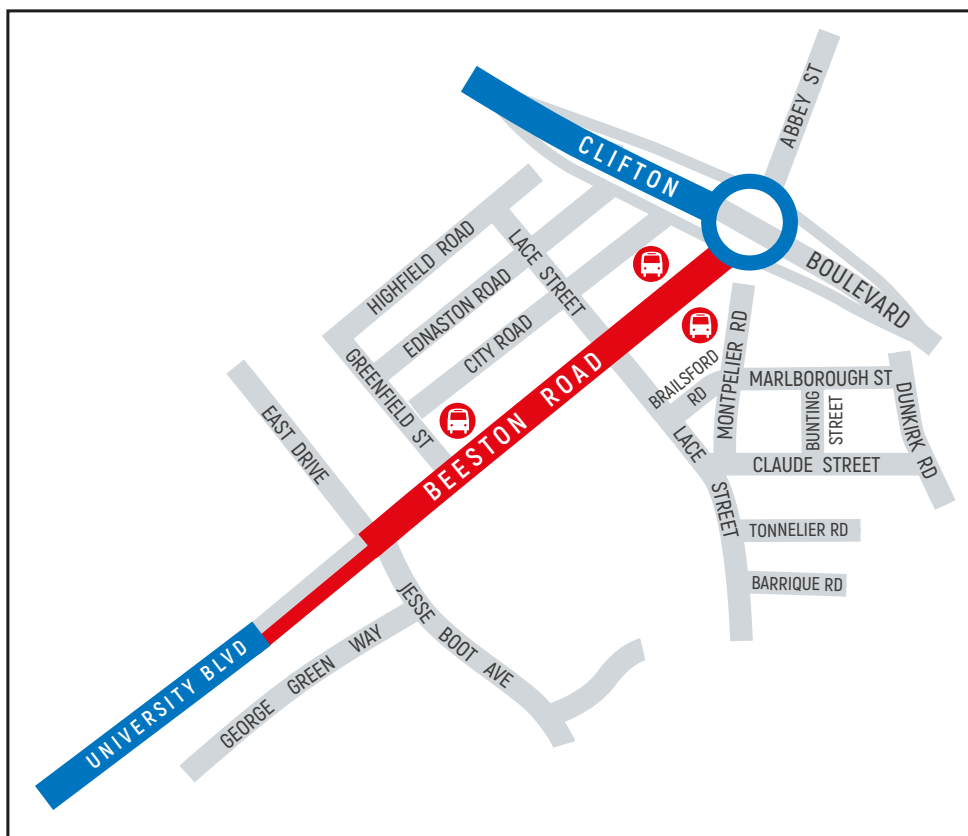
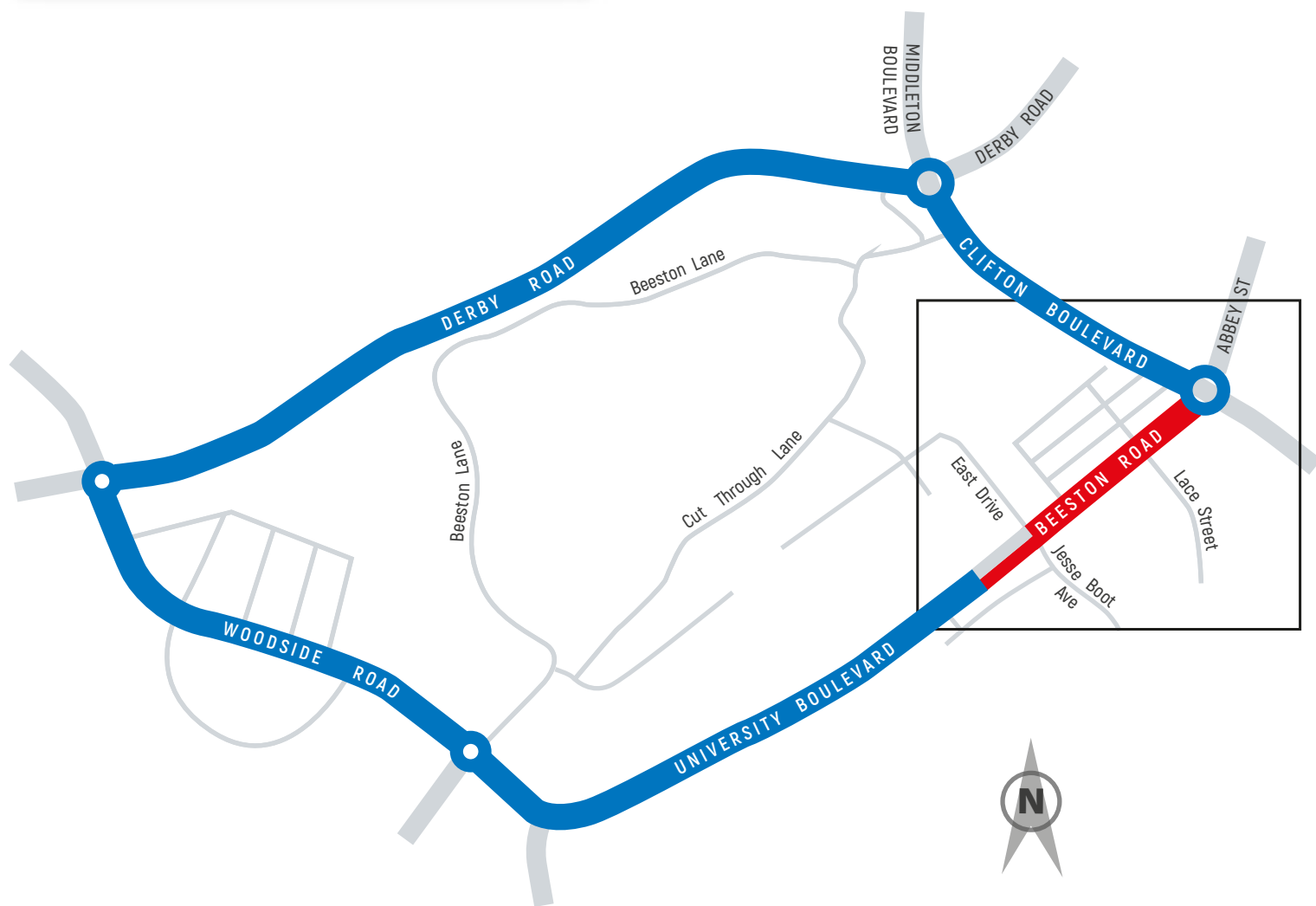
