Nottingham City Council is improving your road

Nottingham City Council is resurfacing Cockington Road from Bilborough Road to Brindley Road. Works will be taking place from Monday 3rd August until Friday 21st August. Hours of work will be 8am to 5pm Monday to Friday. Please see plan attached showing the diversion route for general traffic.

How will this affect you in general?

- All restrictions are in operation during working hours only.
- Footway access will be maintained at all times.
- No parking to take place on the road. The road will be closed to general traffic with access maintained for residents and deliveries with a local diversion route in place.
- Driveway access will be maintained where possible, but there may be short periods when access is limited. The contractor and traffic management operatives will be on site to help maintain access and minimise disruption.
- Residents living on cul-de-sacs off Cockington Road will be subject to restricted turning movements (left turn only or right turn only) during different phases of work.
- There will be temporary traffic lights on Bilborough Road and Trowell Road when required, to allow safe working at the junctions.
- Businesses will remain open as usual. Customer parking is advised on Birchover Road.
- Buses that use Cockington Road will follow a diversion route.
- Your bins will still be collected on your usual day, please ensure these are placed outside your property before 7am.

Phase 1: Monday 3rd to Thursday 6th August

- Cockington Road will be closed to general traffic with a diversion route in place, access for residents and deliveries will be maintained.
- Civils operations will take place prior to the resurfacing. Localised traffic management will be in place along the road.

Phase 2: Friday 7th to Friday 21st August

- Cockington Road will be closed to general traffic while resurfacing takes place. Access for residents and deliveries will be maintained where possible.
- Residents living on cul-de-sacs off Cockington Road will be subject to restricted turning movements (left turn only or right turn only) during different phases of work as detailed below:
 - Trowell Road to Stotfield Road (southern junction)
 - Stotfield Road (southern junction) to north of Stagsden Crescent
 - North of Stagsden Crescent to Bilborough Road

We are unable to complete the resurfacing of Cockington Road between Trowell Road and Brindley Road at this time and have programmed these works for October half term 19th to 30th October. We will contact you nearer the time about these works.
